Virginia has had a long and diverse nursing career. Following her District Nursing training she worked in East London as a District Nurse and team leader.

Most recently a specialist in Palliative Care Nursing with roles in Palliative Care including Hospital Macmillan Clinical Nurse Specialist; Advanced Nurse Practitioner and Assistant Director of Care & Quality. Virginia has extensive experience working with complex patients and their families and works in collaboration to ensure positive and meaningful outcomes.

Special areas of interest include non-malignant Palliative Care. Virginia was the lead clinician in the Shared Care Liver Project and the Heart Failure Shared Pathway which won her national recognition as runner up for the Nursing Times Liver Nurse of the Year and also an Innovation award from Hospice UK.

Virginia has worked as a Clinical Projects facilitator. Projects have included a collaboration with the local Integrated Care Board to improve quality in the care sector; the development of a Winter Bed Model to ease pressure from the wider health system; development and implementation of a specialist registered nurse competency framework and a project to improve quality of service provision using co-production and co-design frameworks with service users.
